This is one of the core programs of the Department of Health, under the Maternal and Child care, giving free vaccines for all the different childhood diseases to the susceptible populace from birth to 12 months old. The Municipal Health Office gives Bacillus Calmette-Guerin (BCG) vaccine, Hepatitis B Vaccine, PentaValent Vaccine, Oral Polio Vaccine, Inactivated Polio Vaccine and Measles Containing Vaccine to neonate before one year of age.
